- 1) What is the context of this event?
- 2) Describe what happens in verses 2-9.
- 3) Why does Peter initially resist the foot washing? (v. 8)

Why does he eagerly submit in verse 9?

- 4) What are the main points Jesus is teaching in verses 12-17?

- 5) Read Philippians 2: 5-11. What attitude does Jesus demonstrate, and how does He demonstrate it?

- 6) Consider the following verses. What does each instruct regarding the proper attitude about leadership and service?

\*Luke 6: 40

\*1 Peter 5: 5-7

\*Ephesians 4: 2

\*Luke 22: 24-30

- 7) How does the world's view of leadership and service differ from this?

- 8) How would you react if the pastor insisted on washing your feet?

- 9) What is so humbling about letting someone else wash your feet?

- 10) How would you feel about washing someone else's feet?

- 11) What are some practical ways of serving others that might be considered the equivalent of washing someone's feet?

- 12) Meditate on Christ's words in verses 12-17. How can you live these things this week?
