

Timeline






Judges 3:1-2

Now these are the nations that the Lord left, <u>to test</u> Israel by them, ...<u>to teach war</u> to those who had not known it before.

Testing and teaching war

*"Opportunity for spiritual formation"*Trials are like *"Spiritual catfish"*

Surrounded by enemies



Judges 3:3-4 – "Surrounded" Philistines – SW •Moab, Midian, Ammon – SE Sidonians – NW •Hivites – NE •Canaanites – internal threat • Do you ever feel this way?

Judges 3:5-7


...people of Israel <u>lived among</u> the Canaanites...people of Israel <u>did what was</u> <u>evil</u>...forgot the LORD...<u>served</u> the Baals...

•God said this would happen – Ex 34:11-16

Judges 3:8

...anger of <u>the LORD</u> was kindled ...he <u>sold</u> <u>them into the hand of</u>...<u>king of</u> <u>Mesopotamia</u>. And the <u>people</u> of Israel <u>served</u> Cushan...<u>eight years</u>.

Mesopotamia – "amidst the rivers"
God did what He said – Deut 28:25-26



Judges 3:9-11

•Who does what...

•Exodus experience again – Ex 2:24-25

•1st he judged Israel, then he went to war


Judges 3:12-14

...people of Israel ...did what was evil... the LORD strengthened...king of Moab ... ¹³ He gathered ... Ammonites and the Amalekites...defeated Israel...took... city of palms...<u>people</u>...<u>served</u>...the king of Moab eighteen years.

Judges 3:15

Then the <u>people</u> of Israel <u>cried out</u> to the LORD, and the <u>LORD</u> <u>raised up</u> for them <u>a deliverer</u>, Ehud, the son of Gera, the Benjaminite, <u>a left-handed man</u>.

Benjamites ambidextrous – 1 Chron 12:2



Judges 3:16-30 •Uses deceit •Capitalizes on "Bull Calf's" (Eglon) pride •Calls out the people Sound strategy Israel rests 80 years

Is assassination justifiable?


•Moabites, Ammonites, and Amalekites not only neighbors, but also *relatives*

- •Lot (Abraham's nephew), father of Moab and Ammon (Gen 19:30-38)
- •Esau (Jacob's brother) is the ancestor of Amalek (Gen 36:12, Deut 25:17, 19)

Judges 3:31

After him was <u>Shamgar</u> the <u>son</u> <u>of Anath</u>, who killed 600 of the Philistines with an oxgoad...

 Foreigner who saved Israel and defeated the enemy despite limited resources



Are we like the Israelites?
