## Romans 1:1 The Gospel is "theocentric"

Paul, a <u>servant</u> of Christ Jesus, called to be an <u>apostle</u>, <u>set apart</u> for the gospel <u>of God</u>,

Under the authority of His Lord (humility)
Divinely sent messenger (authority)
Prophetic purpose – (Is 49:1-2) & (Jer 1:4-5)
Theocentric – θεός 153 times

Romans 1:2 The Gospel is "salvation historical"

<sup>2</sup> which he <u>promised beforehand</u> through his prophets in the holy Scriptures,

Culmination of prophetic promises
Not something new
Grounded in the OT

Romans 1:3-4 The Gospel is "Christocentric"

<sup>3</sup> concerning <u>his Son</u>, who was descended from David according to the flesh <sup>4</sup> and was declared to be the <u>Son of God in power</u>...

# The Gospel in Christocentric •V3: Ontological – who he is, Eternal Son •V4: Functional – messianic office, Lord

#### Romans 1:3 – "Humiliation"

## <sup>3</sup> concerning his Son who <u>was descended</u> <u>from David according to the flesh</u>

Son of God becomes a man
Messianic line of King David
Born of a woman

#### Romans 1:4 – "Exaltation"

<sup>4</sup> and was declared to be the <u>Son of God in</u> <u>power</u> according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, <u>Jesus Christ</u> <u>our Lord</u>

Son-of-God-in-power = LordPhil 2:5-11

#### Romans 1:4 – Work of the Holy Spirit

<sup>4</sup> and was declared to be the Son of God in power <u>according to the Spirit of holiness</u> by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord

## •1 Cor 2:14 & 2 Cor 3:18

#### Romans 1:5

...to bring about <u>the obedience of faith</u> for the sake of his name among all the nations,

"Inclusio" (book ends): also in Rom 16:26
Goal – lead people to the obedience of faith

the obedience of faith

Obedience involves / emerges from faith
Faith is always accompanied by obedience
(James 2:18) & (Matt 28:18-20)

"Lightning and thunder" – Karl Barth
We are saved by faith alone, but the faith that saves, is never alone – Luther / Calvin

## What does "obedience of faith" look like?

## Unbroken victory? Carnal Christian?Progressive growth with periods of failure

Purpose of obedience: "glorify" Jesus Christ
"Glory" serves to bring people to salvation

<sup>5</sup> through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of his name <u>among all</u> <u>the nations</u>,

Universal appeal
to the Jew first and also to the Greek (v16)

#### Romans 1:6

<sup>6</sup> including you <u>who are called</u> to belong to Jesus Christ,

Effectual calling – the Spirit woos you
It is the Spirit who gives life (John 6:43)
For it is God who works in you (Phil 2:13)

<sup>7</sup> <u>To all those in Rome</u> who are loved by God and called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Decentralized church
Relational unity – Chapters 9-11 & 14-15

Plural – "set apart community of believers"
Eph 1:3-12

#### Romans 1:7

<sup>7</sup> To all those in Rome who are loved by God and called to be saints: <u>Grace</u> to you and <u>peace</u> from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

 Grace – God's unconstrained benevolence
 Shalom – vertical → horizontal → internal (Rom 5:1) (Rom 12:18) (Phil 4:6-7)

### Romans 1:1-7

- •Theocentric, Christocentric and Historical
- •Two phases: "humiliation" and "exaltation"
- To the "obedience of faith"
- •For all nations universal appeal
- •To which God calls us
- •May His grace bring you peace

#### What Defiles a Prope

"And he called the people to him and said to them, "Hear and understand: " it is not what goes into the mouth that defiles a person, but what comes out of the mouth, this defiles a person." 18 Then the disciples came and said to him, "Do you know that the Pharuces were offended when they heard this saying?" "He answered, "Every plant that my heavenly Father has not planted will be rooted up. "Let them alone; they are blind guides. And if the blind lead the blind, both will fall into a pit." "But Peter said to him, "Explain the parable to us." "And he said, "Are you also still without understanding? " Do you not see that whatever goes into the mouth passes into the stoosach and is expelled? 18 But what comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this defiles a person. "For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false witness, slander. <sup>20</sup> These are what defile a person. But to eat with unwashed hands does not defile anyone."

Jesus "humiliation" – phase 1
Jesus "exaltation" – phase 2

Two most quoted messianic verses in the NT

...The LORD said to me, "You are my Son; today I have begotten you. (Psalm 2:7)

... "Sit at my right hand, <u>until I make your</u> enemies your footstool." (Psalm 110:1)

Investiture of messianic royal authority
