Where have we been so far?

- •Received God's grace and peace?
- Received the Gospel by faith?
- Rejoice: you are saved from the lies of sin
- Other's sin? Focus on the Gospel!

διατριβω (diatribō)

- Paul uses diatribe
 - Greco-Roman rhetorical device
 - A forceful and critical verbal attack
- Emails and texts?

Jews believed they're exempt from punishment

- Merit salvation
 - •Rich Young Ruler Matt 19:16-22
- Lineage
 - •John the Baptist's rebuke Luke 3:7-8
 - •Jews appeal before Jesus John 8:31-39

In Rom 2, Paul refutes two other "exemptions"

- Recipients of the Torah
- Recipients of Circumcision
- •Why do they have these false notions?
 - •Fear of revisiting exile resulted in fences?
 - •400 yrs of silence warped their theology?

Do we rely on external religious things instead of God's grace?

Romans 2:17-21a "You should know better!"

¹⁷ But if you call yourself a Jew and <u>rely on</u> <u>the law</u> and boast in God...²¹ <u>do you not</u> <u>teach yourself?</u>

•Your guilt is greater – Jam 3:1

Romans 2:21b-22 "You hypocrites!"

...preach against stealing, <u>do you steal</u>?...one must not commit adultery, <u>do you commit adultery</u>? You who abhor idols, <u>do you rob temples</u>?

•Psalm 50:16-21

Romans 2:23-24 "You're witness is horrible!"

- You who boast in the law, dishonor God by breaking the law... "The name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you."
- Paul is quoting Isaiah 52:5 & Ezekiel 36:20
- Guilt greater boasting publicly dishonors

The Jew's Defense

- [1] if you call yourself a Jew [1] guide to the blind
- [2] and rely upon the law
- [3] and boast in God
- [4] and know his will
- [5] and discern good & evil

- [2] light for those in darkness
- [3] instructor of the foolish
- [4] teacher of little ones
- [5] embodiment of the law

The Charges Against Them

```
[1] you teach others
[2] you preach not to steal
[3] you say no adultery
[4] you who despise idols
[4] do you teach yourself?
[5] do you not steal?
[6] do you commit adultery?
[7] do you not rob temples?
```

The Proof
You actions dishonor God

[5] you who boast in the law [5] don't you break the law?

Romans 2:25 "You bear the sign of the covenant!"

...if you break the law, your circumcision becomes uncircumcision

- Circumcision not visible, but actions are!
- •Reminded multiple times/day no excuse!

Romans 2:26-27 – hyperbolic comparison

- 26 ...if a man who is uncircumcised keeps the ...the law...he who is physically uncircumcised but keeps the law, will condemn you...
- •100% obedience required
- •Gal 3:10 / Jam 2:10 / Matt 5:48

Romans 2:28-29 Re-definition of a "Jew"

- 28 ... <u>circumcision is a matter of the heart, by</u> the <u>Spirit</u>...
- A "child of the covenant" is spiritually born"
- Circumcision of the heart
 - Removal of any obstacles to full obedience
 - Internalizing God's external action Dt 30:6

Summary: outward religious things do not save

- Law does not save
- Circumcision does not save
- Lineage does not save

Remember the video?

- Some trust in outward religious practices
 - Never doubt they're a Christian
 - Relationship w/other Christians, not God
- Some trust in nothing
 - Disregard God entirely
- •Both have same problem don't know God

Cultivate devoting ourselves to knowing God

- Cultivate: "to prepare, use and develop"
- Jesus' devotional life
- Jesus' devotion to submitting to God
- Jesus' devotion to other people
- •The Holy Spirit is there to help!

Only thing that saves is trusting...

- •Sola Scriptura according to the Scriptures
- •Sola Gratia we are saved by grace alone
- •Solus Christus in Christ alone
- •Sola Fide by faith alone
- •Soli Deo Gloria to the glory of God alone

Summary: outward religious practices don't save

- Law does not save
 - •Does Christian disobedience honor God?
- Circumcision does not save
 - •Do we "adorn the Gospel"? (Titus 2:9-10)
- Lineage does not save
 - •B/C we're raised in Christian home/church?
