Where have we been so far?

- Greeting and Introduction of the Gospel
- •All have sinned, we need the Gospel
- Law reveals, defines, increases
- Faith: to take God at His word and obey
- Past secures the future & guides our present
- Sin is not your master, choose life

Indicative / imperative construction

- Indicative statement of truth
- •Imperative command / prohibition
 - Past indicatives & present imperatives
- "Do / don't" or "obedience of faith"?
 - Inviting us to become who we are
 - We struggle of the "already and not yet"

Romans 6:1-2 & 14 Paul's previous diatribe

¹ What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase? ² By no means!

¹⁴ For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are <u>not under law but under grace</u>

Paul's next question

¹⁵ What then? Are we to sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means!

Paul anticipates the next challenge

Paul's answer

¹⁶ Do you not know that if you <u>present</u> <u>yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves</u>, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness?

•Exodus 21:1-6

Romans 6:17-18

Past tense indicatives

17 ...you who were once slaves of sin...having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness.

- •Freedom is not license 1 Cor 6:12
- •Subject to none, servants of all Luther

Romans 6:19 Paul's present tense imperative

19 ...so now present your members as slaves to righteousness leading to sanctification.

- •Why? -1 Cor 6:19-20
- •How much? Rom 12:1

Romans 6:20-21

Status / fruit / result

...<u>you were slaves of sin</u>... <u>what fruit</u> ...<u>things of which you are now ashamed?</u> For the end of those things <u>is death</u>.

•Gal 5:19-21

Status / fruit / result

22 ... you have been set free from sin ... the fruit you get leads to sanctification and its end, eternal life.

•Gal 5:22

Connections & outcomes

²³ For the <u>wages</u> of <u>sin</u> is <u>death</u>, but the <u>free</u> gift of <u>God</u> is <u>eternal life</u> in <u>Christ Jesus</u> our <u>Lord</u>.

- Wages / of Sin / Death
- •Gift / of God / Eternal Life

Summary

- •Go on sinning b/c we aren't under Law? No!
- •We can choose who is our master
- For we have been given Christian Freedom
- Invest by doing right
- This leads to the life promised in the Gospel
