### Where have we been so far?

- •Greeting and Introduction of the Gospel
- •All have sinned, we need the Gospel by faith
- Faith: to take God at His word and obey
- Justification by faith secures your future
- Choose to do right; sin is not your master
- •Struggle is real, but victory is real and is now

#### Rom 8:12-13 Cooperate in Sanctification

# ...but <u>if by the Spirit you put to death the</u> <u>deeds of the body, you will live</u>.

•Jesus expresses it this way – Luke 9:23-24

Romans 8:14 How do we know "we will live"?

# <sup>14</sup> For <u>all who are led by the Spirit</u> of God <u>are sons of God</u>.

Led by the Spirit is proof you are God's child

## Romans 8:15 God's Beloved children

<sup>15</sup> For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but <u>you have received</u> <u>the Spirit of adoption</u> as sons, by whom <u>we</u> <u>cry, "Abba</u>! Father!"

•*Abba* – we are intimately loved sons of God Luke 15:20-24

## Romans 8:16 Assurance

<sup>16</sup> The Spirit himself <u>bears witness with our</u> <u>spirit</u> that we are children of God,

Objective & Subjective truth we are God's
Objective – we <u>are</u> His child b/c He says so
Subjective – hear in our hearts – Gal 4:4-7

#### Romans 8:17

<sup>17</sup> and <u>if children</u>, <u>then heirs</u>—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, <u>provided we</u> <u>suffer with him in order that we may</u> also be <u>glorified</u> with him.

We will suffer w/Him – Rom 5:3-5
Comfort / Short Term trip / Relational pain

Romans 8:18 Inclusio (parentheses) - v30

<sup>18</sup> For I consider that the <u>sufferings of this</u> <u>present time</u> are <u>not worth comparing with</u> <u>the glory that is to be revealed</u> to us.

Present suffering reconciled by future glory
2 Cor 4:16-18

#### Romans 8:19

<sup>19</sup> For the <u>creation waits</u> with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God.

 Personified creation is awaiting its renewal which will come with the New Heavens and New Earth – (Rev 21:1-10)

#### Romans 8:20-21

<sup>20</sup> For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly...<u>in hope</u> <sup>21</sup> that the creation <u>itself will be set free</u> from its bondage...

Why does Creation waits eagerly?
God subjected it to the curse – (Gen 3:17)

<sup>22</sup> For we know that the whole creation has been <u>groaning</u> together in the pains of childbirth until now.

•Like a woman in labor – unbearable pain that is endured b/c of the promise of life

<sup>23</sup> And not only the creation, but <u>we ourselves</u> ...<u>groan</u> inwardly as we wait eagerly for ...the redemption of our bodies.

We yearn for the consummated Kingdom2 Cor 5:1-4

## Rom 8:24-25 Paul's encouragement

<sup>24</sup>...<u>Now hope that is seen is not hope</u>...<sup>25</sup> But if we hope for what we do not see, <u>we wait</u> for it with patience.

Hope is unseen and so is faith – Heb 11:1
πίστης (pistis) – act in accordance w/belief
Hope / faith? Setting your alarm clock

<sup>26</sup> <u>Likewise</u> the <u>Spirit</u> helps us in our weakness.
For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but <u>the Spirit</u> himself <u>intercedes for us</u> with groanings too deep for words.

Helps us when we do not know what to pray
He knows us so well, He too groans

<sup>27</sup> And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the <u>Spirit intercedes</u> for the saints <u>according to</u> <u>the will of God</u>.

Father hears the Spirit's prayers for us
Spirit prays for what is in our best interest

<sup>28</sup> And we know that <u>for those who love God</u> <u>all things work together for good</u>, for those who are called according to his purpose.

Supreme confidence in God's sovereignty
God's love + God's power = Our good

## Rom 8:29-30 End of the inclusio

<sup>29</sup> For <u>those whom</u> he <u>foreknew</u> he also <u>predestined</u> to be conformed to the image of his Son...<sup>30</sup> And those whom he predestined he also <u>called</u>,...justified, and...<u>glorified</u>.

All 5 verbs all in the past tense
Past tense of *future* glory implies certainty

# Summary God, our Father loves us!

- •Those led by the Spirit are God's children
- It is so and the Spirit also assures us it is so
- •We are also assured we are heirs by suffering
- •But all of our suffering is temporary
- And in our suffering, the Spirit prays for us
- •So we can be certain God hears and saves
